Began treating children in 1911. Los Angeles Orthopaedic Hospital began treating Los Angeles' disabled children in 1911. The pioneering practice was first located in a converted horse stable located on its current site at 4400 Flower Street. The Hospital's Charitable Children's Guild and its auxiliaries raised enough money to help convert the one-time horse stable into clinic rooms and, ultimately, a hospital.

One of the largest of its kind. LA Orthopaedic is the largest privately-funded orthopedic specialty facility of its kind in the Western United States.

We've raised more than \$1 million to date. Las Amigas de las Lomas celebrates its 54th year as an auxiliary charity of the Charitable Children's Guild, and has alone raised more than \$1 million to-date.
