## INFORMATION

The Las Amigas de Las Lomas Charity Horse Show is covered by the rules and specifications of the current United States Equestrian Federation Rule Book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damage or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Horse Show Management, their decision to be final.

**Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining, and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk/trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**

**ENTRIES:** All entries must be made on an official entry form and filled out completely, including all signatures and organization membership numbers. Any entry incomplete information for horse or owner, such as a horse • entered as "entry" or "TBA" or any such derivative, or lacking required association numbers or non-member indication, will be charged a \$50 incomplete entry fee. All information must be correct, accurate and legible including the name of the horse and rider. Misrepresentation of a horse's name, class eligibility, failure to properly add/scratch entry, or any other false information given on the entry form shall result in forfeiture of any trophy, ribbon, prize and/or prize money won. Classes will not run with fewer than three (3) entries.

**POST ENTRIES:** Post entries may be accepted on a space available basis. Exhibitors MUST contact the Horse Show Office to determine if post entries are being accepted on any day. If allowed, there may be an additional charge of \$15 per class. Horses/Riders showing in a class in which they are not entered will be charged DOUBLE the class fee.

**ADDS and SCRATCHES:** Horses may be allowed to add classes the day before the class and they will receive full credit for scratched classes, providing they are scratched the day before. If classes are scratched the day of, they will receive full credit less a \$10 per class scratch fee. Medal class fees are not refundable for any reason.

**NUMBERS:** Numbers will not be issued without proof of a USEF membership card. A copy included with entry speeds processing. Management reserves the right to excuse and/or refuse awards to riders wearing no number or the wrong number.

**MASTER CARD AND VISA** will be accepted at the horse show office.

**REFUNDS: No stall fees will be refunded:** Prior to closing date, a full refund will be given. After the closing date and before the day the show starts (July 15), refunds will be given, less an office fee of \$50. Once the show has started, a certificate of injury or illness prepared by an accredited veterinarian must be presented to the horse show secretary prior to the start of the class or classes entered for a refund, less an office fee of \$50. **Any horse not shown in a class or division in which it was entered will have its entry fees forfeited.**

**RETURNED CHECKS/DENIED CREDIT CARDS:** A processing fee of **\$25** will be assessed for all nonnegotiable checks and declined credit card charges. Entries may be retained by payment of entry fees **and** penalties by money order, cashier's check or cash. After the completion of the show, non-negotiable checks and declined cards will be handled in accordance with USEF GR913.

**EXHIBITOR NOTES:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with **all** class restrictions and specifications. Rings will not be held for conflicts. Riders or trainers with conflicts must see the announcer at each ring to make adjustments. Absolutely no refund for scratches after a class has started. Exhibitors must provide a current association membership card, a paid membership application form or a signed affidavit to compete in medal classes.

**DOGS: Please, no dogs!** USEF rules require dogs at competitions to be on leashes at **all** times.

**STALLS:** Box stalls will be \$165 if reserved by close of entries. Feed and shavings will be available to purchase on show grounds. Shavings only allowed in stalls, no straw bedding. Stalls available after **9:00 AM, Thursday, July 14.** Stall fees must accompany entry form. **Late stall fees are \$200.** Portable stalls are 9'6" x 9'6" canvas with doors.

**TRAILER-INS:** There will be a \$35 per day grounds fee for horses trailering in and not requiring a stall.

**ARRIVALS:** Horses may not arrive on show grounds before 9:00 AM, Thursday, July 14. (Any early arrivals will be charged a \$50 Fee), Horses arriving after 6:30 pm must make arrangements prior to arrival as show ground gates may be

locked. All exhibitors must be off the show grounds by 10:00 PM Sunday, July 18. Gates will be locked at that time.

**SCHOOLING:** Ticketed schooling rounds @ \$20 per ticket - Thursday, July 14, **12:00** — 5:00 PM.

**PARKING:** Due to limited parking, each trainer will be issued a parking pass that will allow access to park on the grass. Additional passes may be purchased for \$350 for the 3-day show. Pass must be kept in vehicle and clearly visible at all times while parked on show grounds in designated parking area. Exhibitor and spectator parking will be located on the landfill in the HORSE SHOW PARKING area. Absolutely no vehicles or horses allowed on ball fields. Loading and unloading will be kept to a thirty (30) minute maximum per vehicle. NO PARKING and FIRE LANE signs will be considered tow-away zones. No vehicles may be left on the show grounds following each day's competition. All parking violators will be towed at owner's expense. Security will be provided at all times when show is not in progress.

**No poling of any kind will be allowed on show grounds.**

**JUMPERS:** Ties in jumper classes jump off for first only. Ties for all other places will be determined by the fastest time in the first round among those with an equal number of faults. Order of go will be drawn by Paddock Steward. Speed - time allowed will be measured at 383 yards/minute. Division and reserve champion awarded for most points for same horse/rider combination.

**HUNTERS:** Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

**MEDAL CLASSES:** All medal classes will be run in posted order. No refunds on medal classes.

**RIBBONS AND PRIZES:** Regular and medal classes to receive a prize to first, ribbons to first through eight place. Special classes to receive a prize to first and ribbons to first through eighth. Each division will receive a Champion and Reserve ribbon. Prize money will be made payable and mailed to owner as listed on entry form. **Owner's social security number must be on entry form or prize money will be withheld.** Prize money will be paid within 30 days of the show's conclusion.

**ATTIRE:** Proper show attire must be worn while in the show ring. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible. ASTM/SEI approved helmets with harness fastened must be worn at all times while jumping on the show grounds. All junior riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while mounted anywhere on the show grounds.

**ARENAS:** Horses are not permitted in arenas at any time when a course is set or in the process of being set. Violators may be eliminated and/or fined \$100. Footing in all warm-up areas and competition arenas is all weather sand mixture. Competition arenas are 125' x 250'.

**LOUNGING:** No lounging after 7 AM.

**COURSES:** Courses may consist of any combination of the following: Brush, Gate, Oxers, Post and Rails, Ditch, Liverpool, Walls, Panels, Banks and Coops. Horse Show Management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads in Jumper classes as competition warrants.

**MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competitions grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule (GR 901.29).

**RESPONSIBILITY:** Every horse and rider will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Horse Show Management will, in no case, be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold harmless Orthopaedic Hospital and Las Amigas de Las Lomas, Inc., its directors, employees and volunteers, for any loss or accident to his horse(s) or equipment, which may occur due to sickness, fire or otherwise.

**THE HORSE SHOW MANAGEMENT** reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any rider or exhibitor, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes to facilitate the time schedule

PONY JUMPERS: Open to ponies of any age, 14.2 hands and under in height, that are ridden by an individual who has not reached his or her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. Cash winnings do not influence this classification. All ponies are required to possess a current USEF measurement card or valid measurement form issued by the USEF and it must be shown in the horse show office.

SHARPS and MEDICAL WASTE must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by Show Management.

## SPECIAL CLASSES

### BEST CHILD RIDER

Entry fee: \$30 per horse/rider combination

Open to all junior riders who have competed in at least two (2) over-fences classes. To be judged by horse show officials based on performance, horsemanship and sportsmanship. Entries must be made on **official entry form** available in the horse show office. All entries are due in the Horse Show Office no later than 8:00 AM, Friday. Presentation of award will be made on Sunday, July 17 in Ring I following the last class.

Open to junior and amateur riders who have shown and been judged in at least two over fences classes at this show. 

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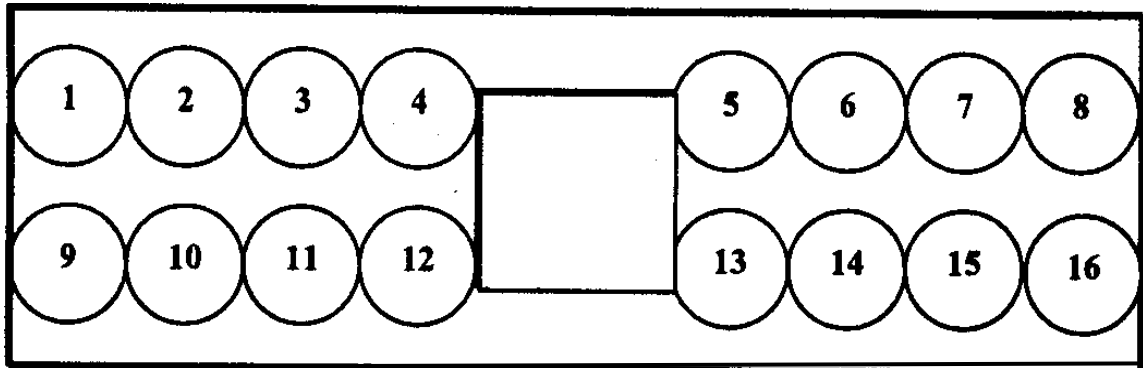

**RELEASE AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS:** I hereby fully and forever release, waive and discharge the RELEASED PARTIES and each of them who are or might be liable in any way from any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of actions, liabilities of any kind which I may or might have against RELEASED PARTIES or any of them, arising from or by reason of any and all known and unknown, foreseen or unforeseen bodily and personal injuries, damage to property, injury to horse and any consequences thereof, which I may sustain due to the ordinary negligence of RELEASED PARTIES; I further agree that except for the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the RELEASED PARTIES, I shall not bring any legal action, claim, demand against and/or sue for any economic and non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage and/or injury to any horse or person in relation

to the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or the operation and conduct of the COMPETITION. I agree this RELEASE INCLUDES ALL ACTIVITIES I PARTICIPATE IN AND ALL AREAS OF THE SHOW GROUND FACILITIES as defined above. This release also includes all activities I conduct at the show grounds facilities and include all times that I am at the show ground facilities no matter what the purpose and/or activity being undertaken.

**HOLD HARMLESS:** I hereby agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless RELEASED PARTIES from and against any and all claims, liabilities, loss, damages, demands, actions, causes of action, including attorneys' fees, cost and expenses of any kind, which may be made against them, or any of them, which arise out of the active or passive negligence of RELEASED PARTIES while either I or any horse at my request or in my control is/was on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES and/or participating in the COMPETITION. I agree to defend released parties at my expense regardless whether released parties are negligent or not.

**ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I hereby acknowledge and assume the risk that equestrian activity, including jumping, is **very dangerous** and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. I expressly acknowledge that injuries may be compounded or increased by negligent maintenance of the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES, faulty or improperly secured equipment, improper supervision or compliance with USEF rules and regulations, Acts of God and negligent rescue operations or procedures of RELEASED PARTIES and negligent handling of horses and independent operations by trainers, riders and/or boarders who use the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES or others who are not affiliated with RELEASED PARTIES. I acknowledge that horses can be injured while being ridden, groomed, stabled, walked and/or exercised and I expressly assume the risk of injury to any horse under my control and/or custody or on the SHOW GROUND FACILITIES at my request.

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California with respect to all RELEASED PARTIES, except for the USEF as set forth on page one. I agree this Release extends to all acts of ordinary negligence of RELEASED PARTIES and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law. If any portion of this Release and/or Entry Blank is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect. I have not relied on any oral representations or statements made that are contrary to or modify the above Release or warnings. I agree that by signing the front page of this Entry Blank that I am bound by the Release, waiver and warnings contained herein and that both sides/pages constitute one incorporated agreement. I agree I have the express authority to sign this entry blank/Release on behalf of the owner and/or rider.
